The Magic of Light

PHASES OF MOON

The introduction to the different celestial bodies was done using stick on and cut outs. The idea of luminous and non-luminous objects was simplified through a prop. Thereafter, Phases of Moon were explained and the children were systematically led to the concept of Rotation and Revolution. Through a video and model, the children were comprehensively enlightened about the formation of Solar and Lunar eclipse.
