

Press Release for the Measles Rubella (MR) Vaccination camp

The Measles Rubella (MR) Vaccination camp was organised on 4th May, 2018 at Delhi Public School, Gurgaon in collaboration with the Health Department of Haryana Government. The aim of the drive is to eliminate Measles and control Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) in the country by the year 2020.

The school under the able guidance of the Principal, Ms. Aditi Misra provided the required infrastructure to facilitate the smooth running of the campaign which will also be held on 5th and 7th May, 2018, vaccinating around 3000+students.

The district level vaccination campaign was inaugurated by Divisional Commissioner- Dr. D. Suresh, PMO Sector 10- Dr. Pradeep, along with Principal, Ms Aditi Misra. The Divisional Information Officer- Dr. Neelam, Urban Nodal Officer- Dr. M P Singh and Dr. Meenakshi of UNICEF also graced the occasion and joined the campaign to shoulder the responsibility to eradicate the deadly disease.

The experienced doctors and highly skilled health workers administered the vaccination to 668 students of the school from classes IV to X. 400 students of Shiksha Kendra, which is a philanthropic venture of DPS Gurgaon that aims at educating children from economically weaker section of the society were also administered the dose. The school had arranged spacious vaccination rooms, a waiting room and several observation rooms. The children were vaccinated in the presence of their parents and were kept under observation for a short period of time.

This drives hopes at improving health and well-being of the children who are the future of our country.
