## SOCIAL SCIENCE-THE TEACHING AND LEARNING OF GEOGRAPHY CLASSES LEVEL :VI-VIII

The DPS Society HRD Centre organized a workshop on the teaching of Social Science with focus on the important constituent of Geography.
