Dear Parents

In view of the recent guidelines issued by CBSE, in case the parents still hire private vans, the following guidelines should be diligently followed:

1. The van should be registered as a commercial vehicle with 'SCHOOL DUTY' written on it. The vehicle should have All Fitness/ Testing/ Permit certificates including CNG Testing if applicable. The CNG kit should be from a reputed company and not from a local company, and the seating capacity should be as per the norms of Registration Certificate.

2. The Driver should wear the uniform with his name plate and badge no. as per the RTO/Motor Vehicle Act/ Govt. rules and have a valid license along with a police verification certificate. He should also possess First Aid Training certificate from the District authorities.

3. Following points should be ensured and looked into by all parents:

- CCTV cameras should be installed in the vans with 90 days recording backup.
- Automatic Child lock mechanism should not be fitted.
- Speed governors should be fitted with a maximum speed of 50 km/ hrs. You should be able to monitor the speed of the van.
- GPS should be fitted so that you are able to locate your child via GPS trackers.
- First Aid box and fire extinguisher is a must in every van.
- Every van should have a glass breaking hammer to combat any emergency.
- You should be able to recognize better and efficient routes via the driver console.

The safety of our children is paramount. Together let's take care of the safety of OUR children.
