

VISIT TO MOTHER DAIRY PLANT, PATPARGANJ

On 13th April, 2018 the students of Commerce stream of Class 12 visited the Mother Dairy Plant in Patparganj, New Delhi. This visit was part of the school's endeavor to provide students an insight in the working of a successful enterprise and to promote learning beyond books.

On arrival at the factory the students were shown a video highlighting each and every activity that Mother Dairy undertakes. The process includes five stages of Standardisation, Fortification, Clarification, Homogenization and Pasteurization.

This was followed by an interactive session where the students were told about the reasons for setting up Mother Dairy and how farmers are helped in many ways. The different environment friendly initiatives like Rain Water Harvesting and the use of Solar Dishes were also explained. The students participated in the session enthusiastically.

Following this, students visited the processing and the logistics areas. The students were also made aware of the rise in adulteration in milk and were demonstrated an experiment to test the same.

It was a very informative visit and made the students understand how the things they learn in school are actually applied in business organisations.
