A day long educational trip was organised for the students of class IV covering few historical and popular places in Delhi like Nehru Planetarium, Gandhi Smriti and Akshardham temple on 8th November'17.

The trip started with a visit to Nehru Planetarium. Students were amazed to see the magnificent building with the model satellite launcher at the entrance. .
