Peer Education sessions on Bullying

With an increase in cases of bullying in the present day schools’ scenario, the Peer Educators of DPS Gurgaon conducted interactive sessions on “Bullying”, for the students of classes VI, VII and VIII on the 11th, 12th and 25th of July 2017.

The module was designed to create awareness regarding the concerns at various levels. It laid emphasis on the behaviour characteristics of the bully, the victim and the bystander. The session further helped students to identify potential bullies. It outlined the different kinds of bullying and equipped students to identify coping strategies to deal with it.
