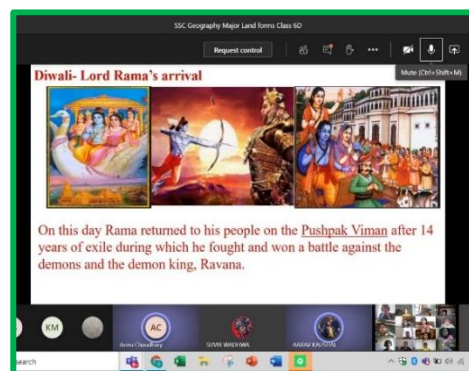


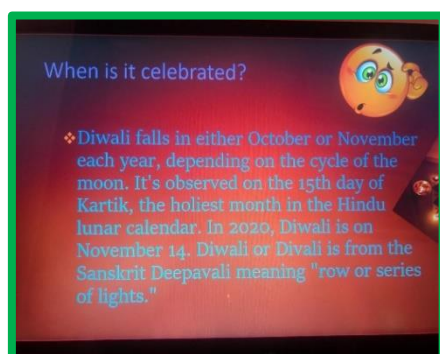
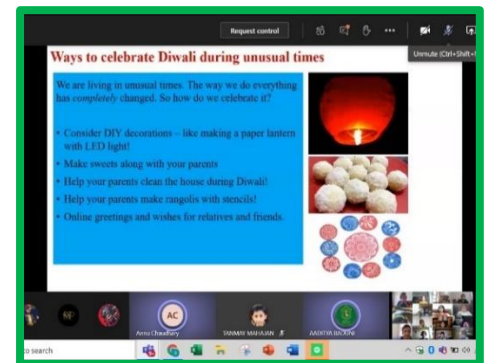
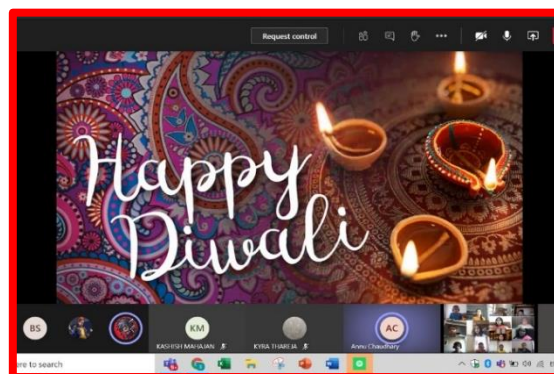
DIWALI ASSEMBLY-REPORT

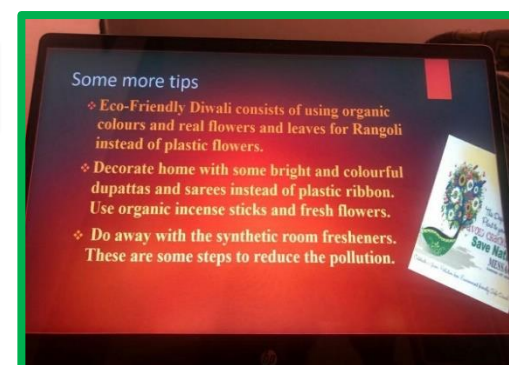
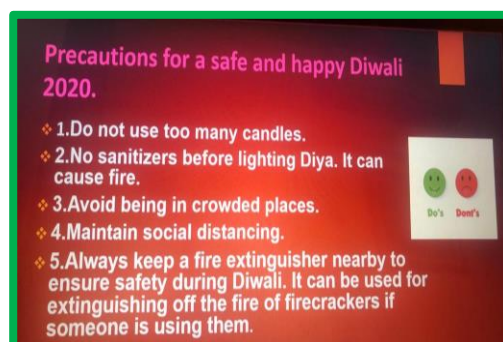

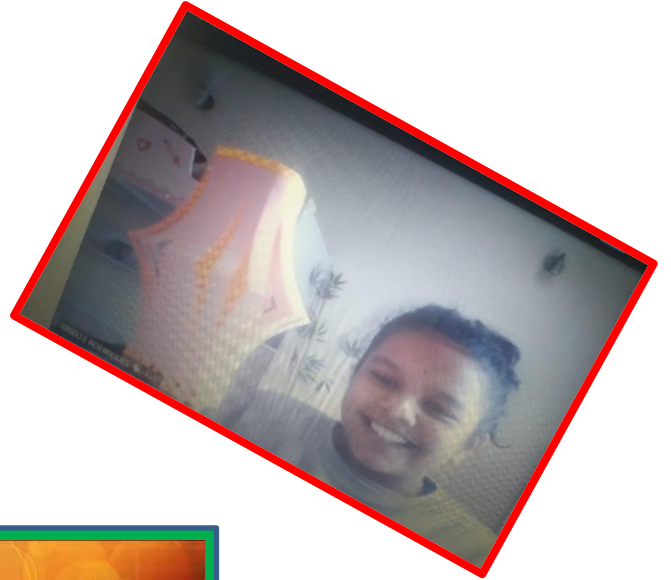
