

ATL CYBER SMART TRAINING SESSION FOR TEACHERS

A training session on Cyber Security was conducted by WCF in collaboration with Atal Tinkering Lab for Science, Mathematics and Computer Science teachers of Delhi Public School, Sector 45, Gurgaon.
