EVENT REPORT

Vedic Mathematics is an excellent tool for developing interest in numbers and making calculations fun. The advantage of Vedic Mathematics is that it has unique tricks and ways of solving complex mathematical problems. Our daily life entails numerous calculations involving basic functions such as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. With this in view, the school organized a workshop on Vedic Mathematics for classes IX and X, on Thursday, September 24, 2020, conducted by Ms. Vidhi Mangla from Pratham. The workshop sought to apprise students of small tricks that they could employ to make their calculations faster—whether it be the square of big numbers or multiplication of a big number with a smaller one. Students were keen to learn and it enabled them to calculate faster and with accuracy. Ms Mangla gave various examples and hands-on practice to the students to grasp the tricks spontaneously. This was evident from the prompt answers to the questions put to them towards the end of the workshop.
