### CEEC /JAL SANSAD ACTIVITY

**Theme:** Damage caused due to climate change

**Participants:** students of class IX and X

A photo caption activity was organized for the students of classes IX and X. Five thought-provoking photographs were shared with the students which shed light on the damage that climate change is doing to our planet. These photographs are some of the finalists for photography app Agora's #ClimateChange2020 competition. The students were asked to give suitable captions to any one of these photographs and explain what the photograph tells them in not more than 100 words.

The activity encouraged discussion and speculation about the photographs. Students analyzed and evaluated the possible scenarios depicted in the photos. This stimulated their imagination and made them aware of the consequences of exploitation of nature. The activity further reinforced the fact that climate change is not some far-off, future problem that we will have to face in a few decades.
