

REPORT ON STORY TELLING

'Storytelling is the most powerful way to put ideas into the world'

To foster the skills of listening and reading, an online session on storytelling was organised for the students of Classes III and IV by Delhi Public School, Gurgaon, on 24th and 25th June 2021. The session was facilitated by Ms. Nupur Aggarwal, a Story trainer and coach from 'Storywallahs'. The event was organised in association with Pitambar- Rising Sun Publications.

She narrated folk-tales from South India for class III involving various characters and kept her audience engaged throughout by using appropriate voice modulation, body language and expressions. She also narrated a folk tale from Punjab, a story of Kaka and Munni for the students of class IV in 'Kamishibai' - a Japanese style of storytelling which drew the attention of the children and left them spellbound. Her storytelling skills brought forth the fact that storytelling is a shared experience among equals in which the audience is just as active a participant as the storyteller. Developing communication skills and expanding the realm of their imagination was the main objective of the session.

Children thoroughly enjoyed the session as it proved to be an extremely engaging experience for them.
