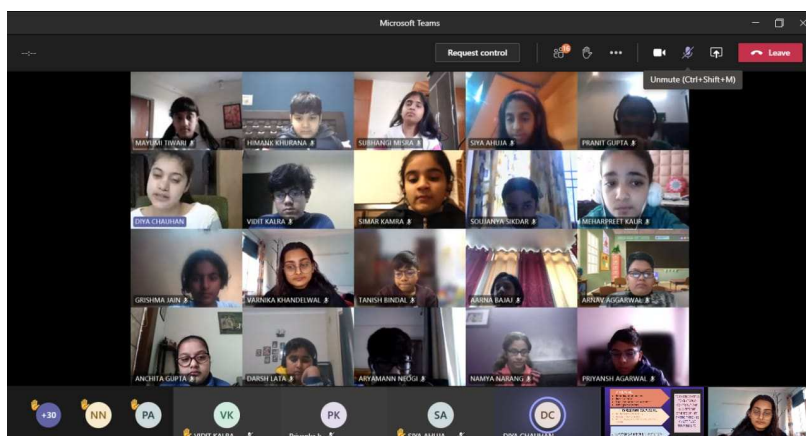
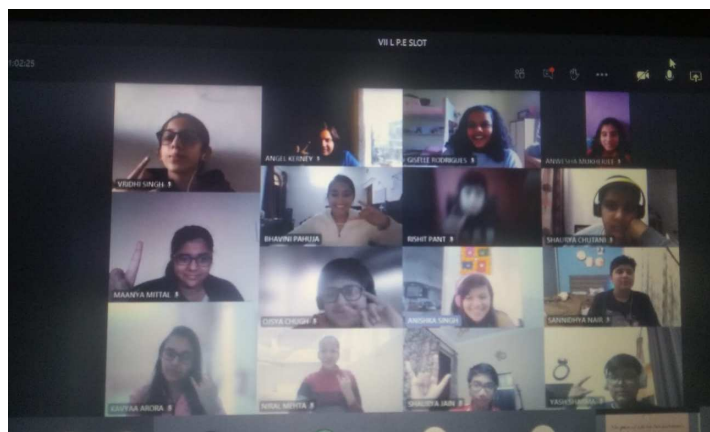


## Peer Education sessions for classes VI and VII
