MINUTES OF THE MEETING

- The meeting started with the Director Principal, Ms. Aditi Misra welcoming all the Parent Reps present. She thanked the Parent Reps who helped with the Draw of Lots

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which ensured a smooth and happy day for everyone, even those whose wards did not make the draw.

- The achievements of the students were appreciated and applauded by all.
- The talent shows and sports events which are an on going process were discussed. Picnics for all classes were being coordinated keeping in mind the weather and pollution.
- Ms. Aditi Misra discussed the various events of the school.
 - Joy of Giving – Daan Utsav, for Shiksha Kendra students, was a success this year too. The motto “Service before Self” was beautifully depicted by the students. Ms. Aditi Misra informed the parents that CBSE, in its Annual Conference, printed a book of essay’s where they selected and printed our school essay on Shiksha Kendra. The Shiksha Kendra Model was appreciated by a number of Principals who attended the Conference.
 - She informed the parents that the school has been trying to host the event “Namaste Deutschland”, in collaboration with German Embassy and Max Mueller Bhawan. She thanked Ms. Pooja Parwanda (HOD German Language) in absentia, for ensuing that this year we hosted the event successfully in October’19. 61 schools (where German language is taught) were a part of the event.
 - Sahyog – Carnival 2019, in collaboration with Parent Teacher Association, will be on Saturday, 21st December’19. The Director Principal mentioned that the Donor Card would be available for a family of 4 to attend the carnival. It would be upto the family whether they wanted the card. (It is not compulsory).
 - Cankids – An event for children afflicted with Cancer, was being organised on Sunday, 22nd December’19.
- The Parents appreciated the new seating plan for the students where there is no back bencher. The Director Principal informed the parents that times are changing and we need to teach the children collaborative learning and peer mentoring.
- The SAP (School Accelerated Programme) was discussed. Ms. Aditi Misra informed the Parents that it is a good programme as it is designed to help the students prepare for Olympiads and competitive exams while giving the child amply time for self studies.
- The “Lead on Programme” for Junior and Middle School students was also discussed in detail.
- The Director Principal shared with the parents about the schools’ initiative in collaboration with Pro India and MCG to combat the menace of plastic. Parents applauded and were enthusiastic to be part of this drive.
