

# DPS, Gurugram, releases anthology as part of int'l collaborative project

An international collaborative project titled *Anthology of Poems: Around the World*, which was spearheaded by Delhi Public School (DPS), Gurugram, was released by its pro vice-chairperson Devyani Jaipuria. This project, a compilation of poems in a flip book, was the culmination of an international collaboration across 21 schools from 13 countries. It involved 29 teachers and 93 poets.

The project aims to address all the major aspects of Sustainable Devel-

opment Goal (SDG) 4 that is the education goal and the Target 4.7 that is education for sustainable development and global citizenship. Jaipuria stressed on how the Covid-19 pandemic has changed our outlook in various ways and that the compilation reflects the paradigm shift in the thoughts of the young poets, who are changemakers of tomorrow.
