REPORT- GUEST SPEAKER PROGRAM

With the aim to create awareness about the harmful effects of single-use plastics and to contribute towards a clean, healthy and plastic-free India, Delhi Public School, Gurgaon, hosted a guest speaker program for the students of class VIII on 28th September 2022.

The session started with a brief introduction of Mr. Rajeev Rana, who is the founder of Re PLAST, a Gurgaon based organisation, which works for sustainable development. This organisation recycles single-use plastics to manufacture interlocking tiles which helps in utilising plastic to save nature.

The students were informed about the damages caused by plastic and the simple choices such as use of steel water bottles and lunch boxes, cloth and jute bags, bamboo toothbrushes etc. that can be made to reduce this damage.

Further, Mr. Rana and his team elucidated about the harms caused by improper management of bio-medical waste and explained the significance of waste segregation and management which can help in saving the environment. He emphasised on the responsibility of each household in waste segregation to achieve the aim.

This session helped the students to gain a deeper insight into sustainable consumption for optimum waste management.
