Report- Remaining 3C's of 21st Century Skill Development

A workshop on the remaining '3C's of 21st century skill development', was conducted for the senior school teachers of Delhi Public School Sector- 45, Gurgaon, on 2nd June, 2023 in the school auditorium.

The resource person, Mr Anansh Prasad, who is a gold medallist chemical engineer, a TEDx speaker and the founder of 'Skill Sphere' commenced the session with a brief introduction of himself and the '21st century Core skills'. The session primarily focused on the development and enhancement of the remaining 3C's of 21st century skill development – creativity, critical thinking and collaboration.

The session was intended to delve deeply into the remaining 3C's of 21^{st} century skill development – creativity, critical thinking and collaboration in order to give the teachers an understanding of how to translate them to classrooms and incorporate these skills indirectly in the lessons.

The resource person presented the participants with many real life situations/problems and asked them to work in groups and come up with solutions, with the intent to demonstrate teamwork and collaboration. The goal of this workshop was to capitalise on the prior efforts and explore strategies for assessing the remaining '3C's of 21^{st} century skill development – creativity, critical thinking and collaboration, with special attention to recent developments of all the three core skills.

The workshop culminated with the teachers sharing their feedback about the session. It was a great learning experience. The teachers got an opportunity to equip themselves with the remaining '3C's of 21st century skill development' to integrated creativity, critical thinking and collaboration in classroom teaching.
