BAGLESS DAY ACTIVITY – 4.0 14th October 23 THEME – CLEAN INDIA, GREEN INDIA CLASSES VI-VIII

"Clean India, Green India" encapsulates the vision of a sustainable and environmentally conscious nation. With the mission to work towards Swachh Bharat, the school organised its 4th bagless day activity for children of classes 6 to 8.

Students started their day by taking swachhta pledge to commit themselves towards the Swachh Bharat mission.
