Worksheet on 3Rs(Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) was discussed, which they completed and mailed to the school librarian.

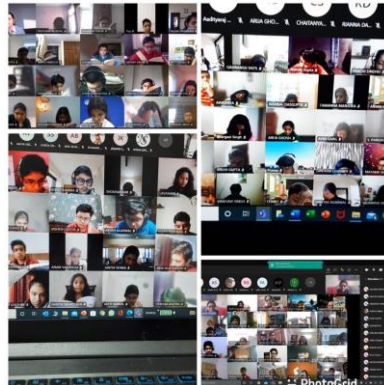


Class VII students created their own Top Trump which is a card game, they were asked to research about various animals living under water. Students did a worksheet on Endangered animals.
