COMPETENCY-BASED EDUCATION

A workshop on Competency Based Education was conducted on 6th February 2021 for the middle school teachers from the Department of English. The vision of the workshop was to put forth the fact that Competency Based Education is the need of the hour for successful learning, living and working. The difference between the Traditional Teaching Pedagogy and Competency Based Education was highlighted. Thereafter, the teachers were told how this particular topic can be integrated with subjects like Science, Social Science and Math. The teachers also contributed their ideas to make the teaching learning process interactive and interesting.
