

Report on English Day

To expand the limit of each child's world and to inculcate in them the love for English language, English Day was celebrated from 12th - 16th July 2021, wherein some fun-filled activities were organized for the students of classes III - V. The virtual classrooms became a hive of activities with students participating with a lot of zeal and enthusiasm.
