

**Educational trip at National Zoological Park  
(Middle School)  
Month-Aug'25**

An enriching educational trip to the *National Zoological Park, New Delhi* was organised for students of Delhi Public School, Sector 45, Gurgaon on 1st August 2025. The visit was part of the ongoing awareness initiative under Project Dolphin, focusing on biodiversity and conservation.

The trip not only broadened their knowledge but also instilled a deeper sense of responsibility toward nature and its conservation. It was truly a meaningful learning experience beyond the curriculum.
