**MATHLETICS-2024**

PI SQUAD, the Mathematics Club of Delhi Public School, Sector-45, Gurgaon, hosted Mathletics-2024, an Annual Inter-School Mathematics Festival, on Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024, Pi Approximation Day. The theme of the fest was ‘Arise! Awake; and Stop not until the goal is reached’ and honoured the concept of Pi. 513 students from 34 schools across the city enthusiastically participated in the fest that had various online and offline activities for the students.
