A day-long professional development workshop on 'Assessing the four language skills' was organized for educators to develop teachers' awareness of the assessment of the four language skills across the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) and the Cambridge English Assessment Scales. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Kalpesh Amin, Master Trainer, Cambridge Assessment English.

The workshop commenced with Mr. Amin introducing the examinations conducted by Cambridge. He highlighted that each exam focuses on a level of the CEFR, helping learners to improve their speaking, writing, reading and listening skills step by step. He introduced various exercises based on the four skills and spoke on how to conduct them in the classroom

He further emphasized that to make learning English fun and stimulating for children, focus should be on practical English language skills. He stressed on the four skills and their usefulness as a tool for describing and analysing specific aspects of language. He also shared practical ideas for evaluating and identifying areas of strength or weakness to develop these skills in class to prepare for tests.

It was an overall very informative and enriching experience, giving an insight into the post pandemic changes in the Cambridge Examinations.
