

GPSC Mathletics-2025: The Annual Inter-School Mathematics Festival

The Annual Inter-School Mathematics Festival, GPSC Mathletics-2025, was hosted by the Pi Squad Club of Delhi Public School, Sector 45, Gurgaon, on 22nd July 2025. The event brought together 694 enthusiastic students from 38 schools, showcasing their mathematical skills through a range of innovative activities.
