

Green Walk – A Tree Identification Activity

Students of Classes VIII to XII participated in an activity organised by the **Eco Club for Mission LiFE**, an initiative of the Ministry of Education, Government of India. As part of the activity, students identified trees across the school campus and created QR codes for them. The initiative aimed to promote environmental consciousness and instil values essential for sustainable living. Students identified plants such as guava, neem, *Plumeria*, *Coleus*, and sago palm, and created QR codes for each. When scanned, these QR codes lead to web pages containing detailed information about the plants, including their scientific names, morphological features, their medicinal and economic significance. This initiative provides easy access to valuable information and enhances learning. The activity was an enjoyable and engaging experience for the students.
