A Parent Teacher Meeting is a common platform, where teachers and parents come together to discuss students’ performance and devise ways to enrich their learning experience. In the current scenario, the school is following a hybrid model of teaching which allowed students to return back to school and appreciate the classroom teaching. In order to sync with the flow of knowledge, PTM was conducted in offline and Virtual mode for classes III-V on 18th December and 20th December 2021.
