PI SQUAD, the Mathematics Club of Delhi Public School, Sector-45, Gurgaon, hosted Mathletics-2023, an Annual Inter-School Mathematics Festival, on Saturday, 22nd July 2023, Pi Approximation Day. The theme of the fest was ‘Arise! Awake; and Stop not until the goal is reached’ and honoured the concept of Pi which approximates to 3.14 mathematically by having 314 participating students. Twenty six schools across the country enthusiastically participated in the fest that had various engaging activities for the students.
