

REPORT – ENLIGHTEN MUN TRAINING SESSIONS

“No matter how complex global problems may seem, they cannot be beyond the power of youth to resolve”.

Model United Nations simulation has emerged as a valuable educational tool that simulates real-world diplomacy. It provides an immersive experience for students to learn about international relations, debate global issues and enhance their critical thinking, public speaking and negotiation skills.

The Enlighten MUN training programme for the students of classes IX to XII was held on 1st, 2nd and 5th of June 2023. The primary objectives of these MUN training sessions is to familiarize students with the United Nations system, develop an understanding of global issues and hone their skills in diplomacy, research and consensus-building. These sessions aim to cultivate leadership qualities, teamwork and foster a sense of global citizenship among participants.

During the training sessions, the facilitators guided the students through the process of drafting resolutions, engaging in diplomatic dialogue and negotiating with other participants. Students were assigned specific countries or roles to represent, encouraging them to research and understand various perspectives on global issues.

MUN training sessions also exposed students to a wide range of international issues, promoting research and in-depth understanding. Engaging in debates fostered critical thinking by requiring students to analyse complex problems and propose innovative solutions. By discussing global issues from different perspectives, students developed empathy and a broader understanding of diverse cultures and world affairs. It encouraged students to collaborate, build consensus and lead through effective communication and teamwork.
