A workshop on the National Curriculum Framework Mandate Document – Guidelines for the development of NCF based on the NEP 2020 was conducted by Ms. Laveena Hemrajani and Ms. Geetu Khanna on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022, for the teachers of the Junior Wing to apprise them about the main features of NCF to be included in the school curriculum.

The National Education Policy envisions an education system rooted in Indian ethos that aims at producing engaged, productive, and contributing citizens for building an equitable, inclusive and plural society as envisaged by our constitution. The workshop aimed at updating the teachers about the ongoing work in NCF. The key highlights were-

- Collaboration in curriculum across all levels of education i.e., from early childhood care to school education, and then to higher education.
- Teachers were given more autonomy in choosing aspects of pedagogy.
- Teachers to focus on socio-emotional learning for holistic development of students.

NCF aims at giving more opportunities and emphasises on experiential learning integrated with skill-based learning.
