

REPORT ON ROAD SAFETY EDUCATION WORKSHOP

'Safety brings first-aid to the uninjured- F.S. Hughes'

As a part of the Guest Speaker Program, a workshop was organized for the students of classes IV and V on the theme 'Road Safety Education' on 17th and 18th May 2022 to create awareness among the students regarding various road safety measures and precautions that should be taken care of.

Mr. Sivasubramanian and the RSO team highlighted the purpose of road safety. Traffic rules and road safety measures such as wearing a seatbelt, not using mobile phones while driving, maintaining speed limit, etc. were discussed with the students. Precautions while riding a bicycle were also elucidated such as putting reflective mirrors, not riding very fast, wearing a helmet and looking for traffic signs carefully.

In continuation, on 18th May, Mr. Girish Gupta, member of District school safety and Road safety committee and Parent Rep of Nursery conducted role play activities and sensitized more students regarding the importance of safety gears, zebra crossing and taking care of pedestrians.
