Visit of Mr. Vikramjit Singh Rooprai from Libration

DPS Sector 45, had the pleasure of hosting Mr. Vikramjit Singh Rooprai from Libration on 27th November 2024. During his visit, he interacted with students during their library slots and conducted various engaging activities designed to promote reading habits beyond their textbooks.

Mr. Rooprai introduced the librarians to a unique library tool called 'Library Engagement Cards', which comes in four types: Performing, Silent, Creative, and Literary. He creatively combined activities from these cards to suit the needs of each class, ensuring that the sessions were interactive and enjoyable. Activities conducted –

Grade IV and V: Students recreated familiar stories but with a twist - changing the nature of the characters and the endings of popular stories.

Grade VII: A lively 'GOAT (Greatest of All Time) Characters' debate was held, where students discussed their favourite characters and what makes them iconic.

Grade VIII: The 'Writing Relay' activity had groups of students take turns to write parts of a story, featuring well-known characters from various books.

Grade IX: Students played 'Book Charades,' acting out books and characters for their peers to guess, adding an element of fun and teamwork.

Grade XI: Two activities were conducted: In the 'Salesperson Activity,' students recommended books to their classmates. The 'Reinvent Your Hero' activity encouraged students to imagine their favourite heroes in new roles or situations, sparking creativity and deeper engagement with the characters.

The sessions were highly interactive and inspired students to explore reading beyond their usual choices. Mr. Rooprai's innovative approach brought books to life, leaving students motivated and excited about reading. His visit truly enriched the school's reading culture and emphasised the joy of reading and creativity.
