

Visit to Ghamroj Village

The students of class XII visited Ghamroj village for a residential project on 13th April '22. Their first stop was a brick factory where they got the opportunity to see the process of making bricks and got first-hand experience by making some themselves. Besides they interacted with the workers and got to know about their means of living, problems, daily routine and livelihood condition. They learnt about how the villagers have to go all the way to the city in case of a medical emergency and other devastating problems faced by them to this day. The students then taught the children of classes II and III at the village school and felt joyous at their smiles.

They then went to an all-girls school and did a street play to spread awareness on hygiene during menstruation and encouraged everyone to break the taboo around it. The students shared their stories and this was followed by a fun-filled singing-dancing session!

The students then explored the village and were enthralled by its old architecture. They learnt how to identify vegetation by the leaves and also about life in the village which was extremely different to what they were used to in the city. They then retired to the bus, tired but enlightened by the experience, and reflected on it on the ride back to school!
