

Pi Squad Activity (Class VI)

The Mathematics Club – ‘Pi Squad’ conducted an activity for the students of class VI on 22nd May 2024. The session began with a short introduction about the school’s ‘Pi Squad’ club and its benefits which was followed by a movie “Donald in Mathmagic Land” showing that Mathematics applies not only to nature, architecture, and music, but also to games that are played on geometrical surfaces including chess, baseball, American football, basketball and three cushion billiard. Through the beloved character of Donald Duck, students were taken on a beautiful journey that brought Mathematics to life, developing a deeper appreciation for the beauty and relevance of Mathematics. To keep the enthusiasm alive, a game ‘Tic – Tac – Toe Mathematics’ was also conducted wherein the students were supposed to fill each of the nine spaces of a 3×3 grid with a unique value from 1 to 9. The one who placed the third number in a column, row or diagonal that added up to 15 was announced as the winner of the game. The game helped the students to develop their cognitive skills.

Pi Squad members ignited curiosity among the young minds to know more about Mathematics and its applications. Students thoroughly enjoyed the activity and had a great learning experience.
