DUSSEHERA: VICTORY OF GOOD OVER EVIL

Dussehra, also known as Vijaydashmi, symbolises the victory of good over evil, commemorating the triumph of Lord Rama over Ravana and Goddess Durga over the demon Mahishasura. On Tuesday, September 24, 2024 the students of VI G presented an assembly on Dussehra: Victory of Good over Evil.
